The Toronto site formulates and manufactures rigid and flexible polyurethane systems used in insulating and non-insulating applications. This includes BASF's WALLTITE® spray-applied polyurethane insulation/air barrier system. In addition to its production and lab facilities, the site is a major distribution centre for MBCC (Master Builders Construction Chemicals) and BASF Coatings divisions. The location is also used for technical training on the application of spray foam, automotive coatings and construction products.

BASF is active in the Toronto community, supporting science education, ecology, health and safety programs and other local community-based initiatives through monetary donations and employee volunteer efforts. The site has supported local organizations such as the William Osler Health System Foundation and is a proud member of the Toronto West Community Awareness and Emergency Response (CAER) committee. Since 2013, the company has delivered its BASF Kids' Lab chemistry workshops to students between the ages of 6-12 across the country. Most recently, offering the sessions through a virtual series.
