

Guidelines for image-capturing at BASF Antwerpen

1. No image-capturing activities are allowed

Capturing images (photos, videos, audio, digital images) on the BASF site is prohibited, whether recording with a photo device, mobile phone, smartphone, mobile device, video or other devices for analogue or digital imaging. This applies to all suppliers, (sub)contractors, contractors, partners, other visitors and BASF employees.


2. Permit granting exceptions

A temporary exception to this general rule may be granted with a specific license. Your contact person at BASF Antwerp can apply the permit for you.

Procedure:

- Ask your contact person at BASF Antwerp to submit an application at least 1 week in advance via [the tool "Photography permits"](#).

When using the tool for the first time, please click:



- The application is processed by the person responsible at the location of the shoot. If the recording is intended for external use, the Communication Department of BASF will also approve or reject this request.
- If recordings are made with a drone, this is done according to the procedure of KWM 09.57. In this case, the application will also be evaluated by BASF's Site Security service.
- If the application is approved, your BASF contact person will receive a permit by e-mail that can be forwarded. Site Security automatically receives a copy of the permit. If the application is rejected, the applicant will receive a motivation for the rejection by e-mail.
- Make sure the photographer or film crew has the printed permit at hand when at work on the BASF Antwerpen site.

3. Rules for the use of recordings

Even with a license to make photos or recordings, their use remains subject to strict rules. External distribution of photographs for publication or information purposes is not permitted, unless BASF Antwerp's communication department granted written permission. Applications for the external use of recordings are automatically submitted to BASF Antwerp's communication department for approval in the tool "Photography permits".
