Products/Uses:

BASF Canada's Toronto site formulates and manufactures polyurethane systems used in insulating and non-insulating applications. This includes products such as BASF's WALLTITE® spray applied polyurethane insulation/air barrier system. In addition to its production and lab facilities, the site is a major distribution centre for BASF's Construction Chemical and Automotive Coatings divisions. The location is also used for technical training on the application of spray foam, automotive coatings and construction products.

Community Relations:

BASF is active in the Toronto community, supporting science education, ecology, health and safety programs and other local community based initiatives through monetary donations and employee volunteer efforts. In 2015, the site donated \$5000 to William Osler Health System. The site is also a proud member of the Toronto West Community Awareness and Emergency Response (CAER) committee.
