As a bulk distribution hub for polyurethane raw materials, the site also services the wood binding and fertilizer markets in western Canada.

Community Relations:

BASF is active in the Blackie community, supporting science education, ecology, health and safety programs and other local community based initiatives through monetary donations and employee volunteer efforts.
