BASF Canada's Cornwall site manufactures monomeric and polymeric plasticizers that are distributed across North America and abroad. Customers use these products in conjunction with polyvinyl chloride to create finished products such as swimming pool liners, automobile interiors, wire insulation and packaging materials.

Community Relations:

BASF is active in the Cornwall community, supporting science education, ecology, health and safety programs and other local community based initiatives through monetary donations and employee volunteer efforts.
