BASF Canada's Nisku site produces concrete admixtures that improve the overall performance, durability and aesthetic properties of concrete. These products are distributed to customers across Canada and in parts of the US and then used in ready mix, manufactured concrete, precast and underground construction segments.

Community Relations:

BASF is active in Alberta, supporting science education, ecology, health and safety programs and other local community based initiatives through monetary donations and employee volunteer efforts.

In 2016, BASF Canada donated \$10,000 to the Canadian Red Cross Alberta Fires Appeal and matched personal donations up to \$1,000 per employee in support of those displaced by wildfires in Fort McMurray.
