The Cornwall site manufactures monomeric and polymeric plasticizers that are distributed across North America and abroad. Customers use these products in conjunction with polyvinyl chloride to create finished products such as swimming pool liners, automobile interiors, wire insulation and packaging materials.

BASF is active in the Cornwall community, supporting science education, ecology, health and safety programs and other local community-based initiatives through monetary donations and employee volunteer efforts. The site has supported several local organizations such as St. Lawrence College, local sports teams and Big Brothers Big Sisters. Since 2013, the company has delivered its BASF Kids' Lab chemistry workshops to students between the ages of 6-12 across the country. Most recently, offering the sessions through a virtual series.
