The Lethbridge site is a Commercial Canola Seed facility which supplies InVigor canola that is produced, cleaned, treated, packaged, and shipped for planting to canola growers across Canada.

BASF is active in the Lethbridge community, supporting science education, ecology, health and safety programs, and other local community-based initiatives through monetary donations and employee volunteer efforts. The site has supported local organizations, including HALO Air Ambulance, Lethbridge Soup Kitchen, Lethbridge Therapeutic Riding Association, Santa's Anonymous Project, Lethbridge Women's Shelter, Lethbridge Food Bank, and Cumming School of Medicine. The staff also has supported Toys for Tots, Shoes for Kids YQL as well as various food banks across the southern Alberta corridor. Since 2013, the company has delivered its BASF Kids' Lab chemistry workshops to students between the ages of 6-12 across the country. Most recently, offering the sessions through a virtual series.
