Preamble

The Würzburg site has been in existence since 1959 and has belonged to BASF Coatings since 1968.

On the 39,000 m² area, innovative coatings for vehicle series painting, with a special focus on water-based basecoats and metallic coatings, are adapted and produced according to customer requirements.

In its Strategy 2025, the EC division is committed to the principles of sustainability. The site meets this demand in particular by producing water-based basecoats and developing new basecoats for its customers' integrated processes.

The purpose of these site regulations is to describe the basic behaviors that are necessary for the safe and smooth cooperation of all organizational structures of BASF and its partner companies at the site. At the same time, the basic requirements that must be observed when operating operating plants, application plants, laboratories, warehouses and other technical equipment are defined.



The site regulations were approved by the plant management and the plant group of BASF Coatings, Würzburg plant. Changes and additions to the basic regulations therefore require the approval of the works management.

The current version of the site regulations is available on the intranet.

1. Introduction

1.1 General / Scope of Application

The Würzburg site is a competence center for basecoats in the global network of BASF's Coatings division. At the site, we mainly produce water-based basecoats instead of solvents. The basic rules contained in these site regulations are intended to create the framework for successful cooperation and secure operation of the site for all companies based at the Würzburg site and external companies operating there. To this end, it is necessary that all persons working at the site take into account each other's interests and, in particular, observe the rules set out below with regard to safety, health and environmental protection.

Territorial scope

These site regulations apply to the following areas (hereinafter referred to as the "site"):

- Fenced BASF factory site in Würzburg,
- Parking areas,
- other buildings, parts of buildings and areas used by BASF, if BASF has declared the site regulations to be applicable.

Personal scope

The site regulations apply to all legal and natural persons who reside at the Würzburg location, in particular:

- BASF Coatings GmbH,
- other BASF Group companies located at the site,
- external companies that provide supplies and/or services at the site for the aforementioned companies (hereinafter referred to as "contractors / work contract partners") as well as the subcontractors used by the contractors / work contract partners to fulfil their contractual obligations at the site,
- all employees of the aforementioned companies,
- Visitors, customers and other persons entering the site.

Liability

The site regulations are issued by the Würzburg plant management. All companies located at the Würzburg site and contractors working here must bindingly recognize the site regulations as part of the contracts concluded between them and BASF or as a separate agreement. They must ensure that the site rules are observed by all their employees, visitors, customers and other persons who enter or drive through the site.

Customers, suppliers, visitors and other persons are informed by the plant security of the applicability of the site regulations when entering the site and must acknowledge the regulations that affect them.

The contractors / contractors are free to issue their own regulations for their employees in addition to the Site Regulations, with the exception of Chapter 2, provided that these do not contradict the provisions of the Site Regulations. However, such additions cannot override the provisions of these site regulations.

The above-mentioned companies will be informed when the site regulations are changed if their interests are affected.

1.2 Violations of the Site Regulations

In the event of culpable violations of the site regulations, BASF reserves the right to take appropriate disciplinary measures, in the case of serious or repeated culpable violations, up to and including a ban on the plant. This shall not affect any further contractual, operational or statutory rights and claims of BASF.

1.3 Structure of the site regulations

The site rules consist of basic rules and additional regulations valid for everyone at the site for:

- production companies, contractors / work contract partners; Laboratories, Application, etc.

1.4 Applicable documents

The documents listed below are valid in their current version:

- Safety, health and environmental protection guidelines (see intranet).

2. Entering and leaving the site

Plant security works on behalf of the plant management and is managed by the responsible department by the respective person responsible for the contract.

2.1 Powers of external plant security

Plant security is responsible for monitoring security and order at the Würzburg site. To fulfil these tasks, the plant security has the powers described in more detail below. Orders of the plant security must be followed immediately and without restriction. Plant security monitors all passenger and vehicle traffic at the site.

Applicable documents

For plant security, the following documents apply in the current version

- Procedural instructions BASF
- Instructions for plant security
- Individual service instructions for plant security
- Individual Regulations of BASF / Plant Security
- Patrol Organization BASF / Plant Security

2.1.1 Access authorization

Only people with a valid ID are allowed to enter the site. The ID cards are non-transferable and must be worn visibly. The minimum age for people who want to enter the site is 18 years old. This does not apply to young people under the age of 18 for the purpose of training.

Further exceptions must be applied for from the plant management. Automated access (access control system) must be used at the factory gates; otherwise, the work ID card must be shown to the plant security without being asked. The access control system checks whether the badge entitles the holder to access. The access authorization is recorded. The data is only evaluated after prior, internal coordination. Incorrect operation and access attempts with blocked ID cards are registered by the access control system. Drivers also need a valid entry permit to enter by car (see Chapter 2.2.2)

2.1.2 Refusal of access

Plant security is obliged to deny access to persons who pose a danger to the safety and order of the persons at the site, the surrounding neighborhood or the site as a whole. In the event of an attempt to gain access with a blocked or invalid ID card or in the event of any other unlawful use of the ID card, the plant security can deny the ID card holder access to the site and confiscate the ID card. Persons who are visibly under the influence of alcohol or other addictive substances for plant security purposes may use the location even if they are in possession of a valid ID. If alcohol or other ingestion of intoxicants is detected during the entrance or exit inspection, or if a person is denied access because of the potential danger emanating from him, the plant security immediately reports the facts

- to inviters / contact persons (for external visitors),
- to the sponsors of the external companies and location partners, suppliers and all other

For its own employees, the provisions of the corresponding works agreement **BV-WÜ** apply.

2.1.3 Checks at the factory gates

Within the framework of the legal rules, regulations and works agreements, the plant security is entitled to carry out random checks of vehicles, bags, etc., especially in the event of suspicion of criminal offences.

2.1.4 Container checks at the entrance and exit at the factory gates

Plant security is entitled to inspect containers and bags carried by non-workers. Inspections of containers, bags and vehicles carried by plant employees are generally only carried out if there are reasonable grounds for suspicion of a criminal offence or administrative offence or an order from the plant

management. For this purpose, the relevant works agreement must also be observed (**BV-WÜ**).

The person concerned has the right to involve a person of his or her trust who can be reached at the site during the checks. If the person concerned refuses to be checked by plant security, the police can be called in.

2.1.5 Other rights of access, search and control

Plant security is entitled to enter and search all objects, premises and motor vehicles at the site at any time if an immediate danger to the safety of persons at the site, the surrounding neighborhood or the site itself must be averted. This also applies if there is a reasonable suspicion that a crime affects the safety of persons or the location.

2.1.6 Items Carried

It is prohibited to bring alcoholic beverages or other intoxicating substances to the site. It is forbidden to bring weapons, explosive devices and other dangerous objects to the site. Exceptions must be approved by the works management. Other items carried along that are not needed on the factory premises for the performance of the respective work can be deposited at the factory gates in individual cases. BASF does not assume any liability for landfilled items.

2.2 Identity cards and permits

2.2.1 General Regulations

Identity cards and permits can be issued permanently or for a limited period of time. The ID offices are responsible for issuing work ID cards. Plant security issues temporary ID cards at the factory gates. At the request of the plant security, ID cards and permits must be shown or handed over, unless otherwise provided for in the following regulations.

Issuance and return of ID cards

The work ID card is issued after consultation with the respective departments.

The respective ID offices are:

for BASF employees	= Human Resources Department,
for employees of contractors	= Plant security,
temporary company ID cards	= Plant security

When creating an identity card, legitimation is required by means of one of the documents mentioned in the original:

- Identity card
- Passport
- Driving licence

When submitting the application or maintaining master data, the applicant must provide proof that the legal provisions (e.g. residence and work permit law) are complied with. Forgotten or lost ID cards and permits must be replaced. Lost ID cards must also be reported immediately to the security service / ID offices for the purpose of blocking. Identity cards and permits that are no longer needed or invalid must be returned to the plant security / ID offices or sent back informally by post. The same applies even after a ban on works or corporations has been pronounced. Illegally used ID cards and permits will be confiscated by plant security. Identity cards and permits lose their validity if the data printed on them or the data and facts on which the application is based no longer match the person or the employment data (e.g. in the event of a change of company).

The requesting body is responsible for updating the data (ID card exchange) or reapplying (ID card return).

The factory ID cards are not transferable! Holders of the work ID card are prohibited from using their personal work ID card to allow third parties to enter / exit the work.

2.2.2 Special or entry permits

Only vehicles that are directly required for the provision of services or that have an entry permit will be admitted to the factory premises. All other vehicles must be parked outside in the parking spaces located there. Driving on the factory premises with private two-wheelers of any kind is prohibited. (folding bicycles brought along may be taken to the factory premises when folded)

In order to reduce traffic on the factory premises, the issuance of entry permits will be handled restrictively.

2.3 Obligation to report and provide information

2.3.1 Reporting obligations

Dangers to the safety of persons at the site, the surrounding neighbourhood or the site as a whole, as well as planned or already committed criminal offences, administrative offences and violations of the site regulations, must be reported immediately to the RC plant management department and the site security.

2.3.2 Obligations to cooperate

In principle, every person must cooperate comprehensively in the clarification of a reportable fact.

2.3.3 Restrictions on the reporting and cooperation obligations

To report or participate in accordance with Section 2.3.1. and 2.3.2. is not obligated to anyone who would thereby expose themselves to the risk of their own criminal prosecution or the prosecution of a close relative (e.g. fiancé, spouse, life partner, direct relative).

2.3.4 Responsibility for clarifying the facts

Violations of safety and order at the site, such as theft, must always be reported to plant security. In any case, plant security will clarify the facts. If necessary,

the head of plant security or his or her representative will call in the police to investigate and inform the insurance department.

2.3.5 Access, search and control rights to investigate violations

Plant security may enter and search all objects and premises at the site at any time if an immediate danger to the safety of people at the site, the surrounding neighborhood or the site itself must be averted. This also applies if there is a reasonable suspicion that a crime affects the safety of persons or the location.

3. Behavior at the location

3.1 Entry by non-workers

Visitors and contractors register at Gate 1. Suppliers and goods collectors also register at Gate 1 during the opening hours of incoming goods. The plant security employees establish contact with the responsible unit or specialist department of BASF, contractors / work contract partners. When temporary ID cards are issued or handed over, the acceptance of the safety instructions must be confirmed by the non-worker with a signature. The ID cards handed out must be worn on the factory premises at all times, open and clearly visible. In addition, depending on the group of people, the following will be handed out:

- Safety instructions for visitors to BASF Coatings GmbH, Würzburg plant
- Safety instructions for truck drivers

Production facilities, laboratories and warehouses, especially rooms with automatic gas extinguishing systems, may only be entered if the most important safety and conduct rules have been conveyed in advance and there is an official requirement.

Visitors will be informed of the possible hazards by the plant manager / BASF companion.

All other persons must be demonstrably instructed (in writing) with the available media before entering these areas.

Visitors and persons without appropriate written proof are only permitted to enter these areas if they are constantly accompanied by a member of the work.

3.1.1 Registration of non-employees

In the case of planned visits or work assignments by non-workers, they must always be registered in advance by the visitor in the visitor management system.

3.1.2 Pick-up by non-workers

Visitors are registered with the visitor by the plant security. The receiving body is responsible for the safety of the non-worker. This determines whether the visitor is picked up at the gate. becomes. Persons from outside the plant with whom it is not possible to communicate sufficiently and "the important safety rules" cannot be conveyed elsewhere will only be granted access to the plant if the receiving internal department / work contract partner picks them up at the gate and accompanies them during their stay on the factory premises.

3.2 Prohibition of smoking, alcohol and drugs

Smoking, alcohol and drug consumption is generally prohibited at the entire site (including in vehicles).

There is a general ban on smoking at the entire Würzburg site. This also applies on roads or in vehicles on the factory premises.

Two smoking pavilions next to G019 are exempt from this. The parking lot is also exempt from the smoking ban.

It is prohibited to bring or consume alcoholic beverages on site. Exceptions require the prior written approval of the works management.

Excluded from this regulation are gifts (from employees or for employees of external companies) as well as quantities required for food preparation in the kitchen operation of the company canteen. The basic
The ban on the consumption of alcoholic beverages on the factory premises remains unaffected.

It is forbidden to bring drugs into the site or to consume them there.

3.3 Entering Work Areas

No company buildings or factory areas may be entered without official necessity. Every external person who enters a company with a registration office, a laboratory, an administration or another building is obliged to register and deregister.

3.4 Duty of confidentiality

All persons working at the site must treat the knowledge they have acquired about the operational or business processes of BASF and other BASF Group companies as well as all technical and commercial information relating to them as strictly confidential.

3.5 Immediate measures and what to do in the event of an accident or damage

After an accident or damage event, all necessary measures must be taken immediately to care for the injured and avoid any consequential damage. All injured persons must be presented to the company doctor / emergency doctor / hospital for initial medical care.

In the event of damage, the following applies:

- do not hinder rescue work,
- do not walk or drive through spilled danger areas,
- Do not enter or drive on restricted areas

In the event of danger or when acoustic danger signals are sounded (signal horn of the CO2 system or telephone system (evacuation order)), the following applies:

- Leave the danger area, if possible perpendicular to the wind direction,
- immediately go to the designated assembly point at the car park,
- follow the instructions of the operating personnel or the company fire brigade within companies, plants and buildings



It is always necessary to call 112 first

In the event of an incident, personal injury/fire should be avoided after the emergency call has been made.

the 222 are called to inform plant security that an ambulance or a fire engine of the professional fire brigade comes to the plant.

3.6 Emission events

Emission events (emissions into the air, leakage damage, soil contamination) must be reported immediately to the Responsible Care and/or Responsible Care unit.

3.7 Road traffic at the site

The maximum speed allowed for all vehicles at the site is 20 km/h and 10 km/h in the parking lot. The rules of the Road Traffic Regulations and the Road Traffic Licensing Regulations are applied analogously at the site. Parking is only permitted in the separately marked areas. Deviating regulations are only possible after consultation with the site management. Due to the high number of areas where pedestrians and vehicle traffic, especially forklift traffic, meet, we expressly point out that we are therefore strongly dependent on mutual consideration at the Würzburg location are. As a pedestrian, please always make eye contact with the vehicle driver, especially forklift drivers.

3.8 Prohibition of photography and filming, use of mobile phones

Photography and filming, regardless of the device (cameras, video cameras, mobile phones) is generally prohibited at the site. Exemptions (e.g. for contractors) are determined by the plant management.

BASF Coatings employees are permitted to take photos, audio and moving images with BASF equipment for official purposes. Subject to legal, judicial or official disclosure obligations, they are obliged to keep secret, not commercially exploit, not to pass on to third parties or to make them accessible to third parties in any other way all technical, scientific, commercial and other information that becomes known to them, whether directly or indirectly.

The obligation of confidentiality shall apply beyond the termination of the assignment. The only exceptions to this confidentiality obligation are information that is lawfully obvious (generally known and therefore no longer secret or protectable).

Employees are obliged to ensure that third parties involved (employees, contractors, external partners, etc.) are subject to the same confidentiality obligation. Compliance with this obligation must be documented in a comprehensible manner. The recording of conversations without the consent of the parties involved is prohibited. In all other respects, the provisions of the works agreement must be complied with.

Photos and films - external use

Recordings that are used externally, by the public must be approved by the responsible unit (plant manager or his superior). Photos and films that are to be published must be approved by the responsible public relations department.

When taking pictures of people, the personal rights of the people recorded must be observed.

The use of non-ex-protected mobile phones in Ex areas is generally prohibited. In all other respects, operational interests must be taken into account.

3.9 Video surveillance

In certain areas, the area is under video surveillance for security reasons.

3.10 Use of the company restaurant

The services of the company restaurant can be used by all persons at the location. The company restaurant may only be entered in clean clothing. Under no circumstances may materials such as raw materials, intermediate and finished products be taken into the area.

3.11 Disturbances of the peace of the location

All actions and behaviours that are likely to impair the fruitful cooperation of the persons working at the location must be refrained from. In particular, without BASF's consent, it is prohibited to:

- to put up posters or write on walls,
- distribute leaflets, handouts or printed materials,
- sell or advertise goods,
- to hold public meetings and events,
- to carry out public party-political activities, and
- to carry out public collections of money and signatures

The rights of employee representatives and trade unions under the Works Constitution Act and the Collective Agreements Act remain unaffected by this.

3.12 Food and drink at work

The transport, storage and consumption of food and beverages is prohibited in areas with open chemical handling.

Clean hands thoroughly before eating to avoid the spread of hazardous substances.

3.13 Operation of machines and systems

Machines and systems may only be operated by employees after instruction and safety instruction have been completed.

4. Transfer of goods and materials

4.1 Tor use

For the movement of goods by trucks / vans, the following regulation applies during opening hours:

Enter through Gate 1, exit through Gate 2.

Special transports such as heavy transports, bulky goods and equipment must be coordinated with the responsible specialist unit in good time. Exemptions must be notified to the plant security by the responsible specialist unit.

4.2 Imports

All imports must be reported by means of appropriate accompanying documents, e.g. delivery note for goods, material/machine/tool list for machines, tools and other work equipment. Plant security is entitled to carry out appropriate checks.

4.2.1 Importation of private property

When introducing private property, registration must be made in advance in the Lotus Notes system (submission/borrowing slip), which must be approved in advance by the responsible supervisor.

When importing, the permit must then be presented to the plant security without being asked.

The following items may not be imported into the site:

- E-bike battery and charger (charging of e-bike batteries prohibited on the factory premises)
- Electric kettle
- Private computers

If the import involves mobile electrical work equipment, it must be subjected to a DGUV 3 test before it is put into operation at the site. Without this test, the device must not be used.

4.3 Exports

The export of material requires written approval by an authorized person of the respective BASF unit. The currently valid forms, the submission/borrowing form must be deposited in electronic form in the submission system. Please make sure that you always carry the corresponding long-term loan slip with you when renting equipment on a permanent basis. When borrowing several IT devices, a certificate listing them all is sufficient. If BASF makes items available to employees at the site for private purposes (private levy), the surrender/borrowing form must also be used for this purpose.

The surrender/borrowing form must be available in electronic form for the security service in the submission system. In addition, the original printout from the submission system must be shown.

4.4 Dangerous goods inspections

The legal and operational regulations for the transport of dangerous goods must be observed. All units responsible for unloading or loading carry out coordinated checks. Vehicles and drivers who do not comply with the legal and operational requirements are generally not permitted for loading or unloading. Complaints and denied entrances will be reported to the responsible authorities and appropriate measures will be taken. If a complaint is found during the exit, the exit will be refused until clarification.

5. Applicable Documents, Laws, Regulations and Security Guidelines

Laws, regulations and safety guidelines must be observed. The application and design may be decided by the respective BASF departments.

The following documents are valid in their current version:

- Contractor management for the use of external companies at BASF Coatings GmbH
- Plant alarm plan
- Concepts
- Wastewater concept
- HSE Management
- Disposal regulations
- Transport safety
- Directive on Permits, Permits and Other Regulatory Approval Decisions
- Location-based security policies

6. Right to give instructions


When implementing and complying with the site regulations, the Responsible Care Würzburg department, the site's human resources department and the site's logistics department have a functional right to issue instructions.



In the event of an alarm, the assembly point assigned to the Würzburg location must be visited immediately and the completeness must be determined. Rescuing people takes precedence over firefighting!



CO² extinguishing areas are marked by yellow signs at the entrances. These areas are protected by an automatic extinguishing device for firefighting.

When the horn sounds, the building must be left immediately and the collection point must be visited. There is an acute danger to life!

After the warning time (30 seconds) has elapsed, the doors and windows close automatically. The doors can still be opened by hand at any time. Inhalation of increased carbon dioxide concentrations leads to suffocation after a very short time. Work in which it is not guaranteed that the rooms will be left within the warning time, e.g. driving on containers, work on scaffolding, lifting equipment, etc., may only be started when the automatic CO² extinguishing has been taken out of operation by the company fire brigade. The documentation is done in the permit certificate. Emergency exit doors, escape routes, stairs, other entrances/exits must not be blocked or their automatic closure may be overridden.

Hazardous substances with the GHS symbols shown are handled at the site. The protective measures are listed in the associated safety data sheets and must be observed.



In a chemical plant, personal hygiene of employees is of paramount importance. Eating and drinking is only allowed in the designated rooms. Soiled work clothes must be changed in good time. Clothing that has come into contact with chemicals must be changed immediately.

Leakage damage and other environmental damage must be reported immediately to the company fire brigade (emergency 0931/9084-222, otherwise Tel. 0931/9084-218). The spread of damage must be limited by suitable measures (e.g. covering drains).



The appropriate protective equipment must be worn in the marked work areas.



Ex areas may only be entered with safety shoes with antistatic soles (at least EN 345 S1). Visitors are also allowed to wear sturdy shoes with electrostatic leakage strips. The function of the drainage strip must be tested with a test device. In hazardous areas, it is generally prohibited to carry or use devices that can become a source of ignition, e.g. mobile phones, non-explosion-proof motor vehicles, transport vehicles, tools, walkie-talkies, flashlights, small appliances such as calculators, lighters, matches, etc. A permit is required for work in hazardous areas.



Warning of Explosive Atmosphere

Ex areas are marked by yellow signs at the entrances (Explosive Atmosphere Warning) Additional regulations and rules of conduct must be observed.

Vertical ladders: The use of vertical ladders as an ascent is only permitted at the entire site with an existing order and a risk assessment/permit certificate.



Maximum speed on the factory premises is 20km/h, park vehicles in marked parking areas and must not block access to safety equipment!



Warning of Industrial trucks

Traffic of industrial trucks on the entire factory premises



Absolute smoking ban on the entire factory premises including vehicles.



Hazards from magnetic and electromagnetic fields cannot be ruled out. Persons with influenceable body aids must report in advance.



The operation and starting of machines, systems and switches is prohibited.



The transport, storage and consumption of food and beverages is prohibited in areas with open chemical handling.



Photography ban at the entire site (only possible with special permission).



Electrical devices such as laptops or mobile phones are prohibited in designated areas. The only exception: specially approved devices in Ex design.



Absolute ban on alcohol and drugs on the entire factory premises.



Animals are prohibited.



Working at height always with Fall protection



Removing and bypassing Safety forbidden



No access for people with pacemakers. (Specially marked areas)
