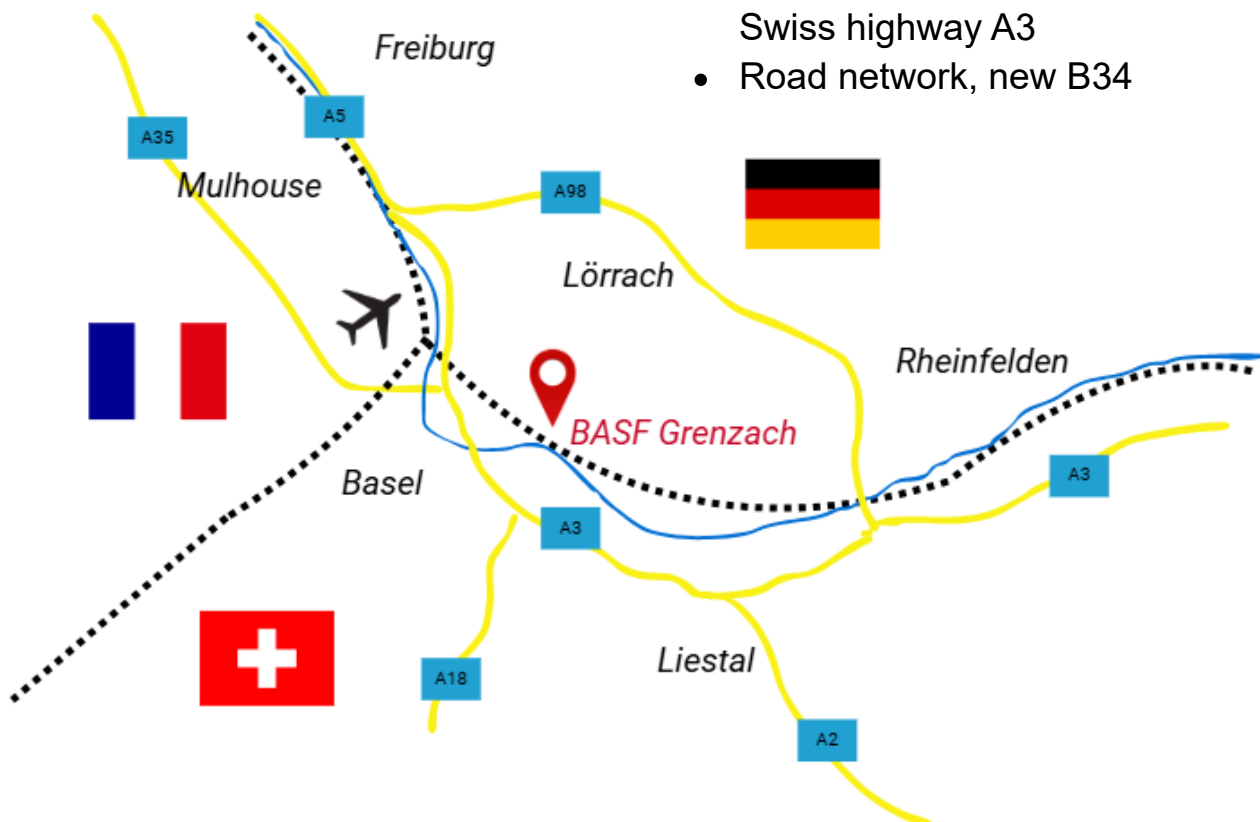

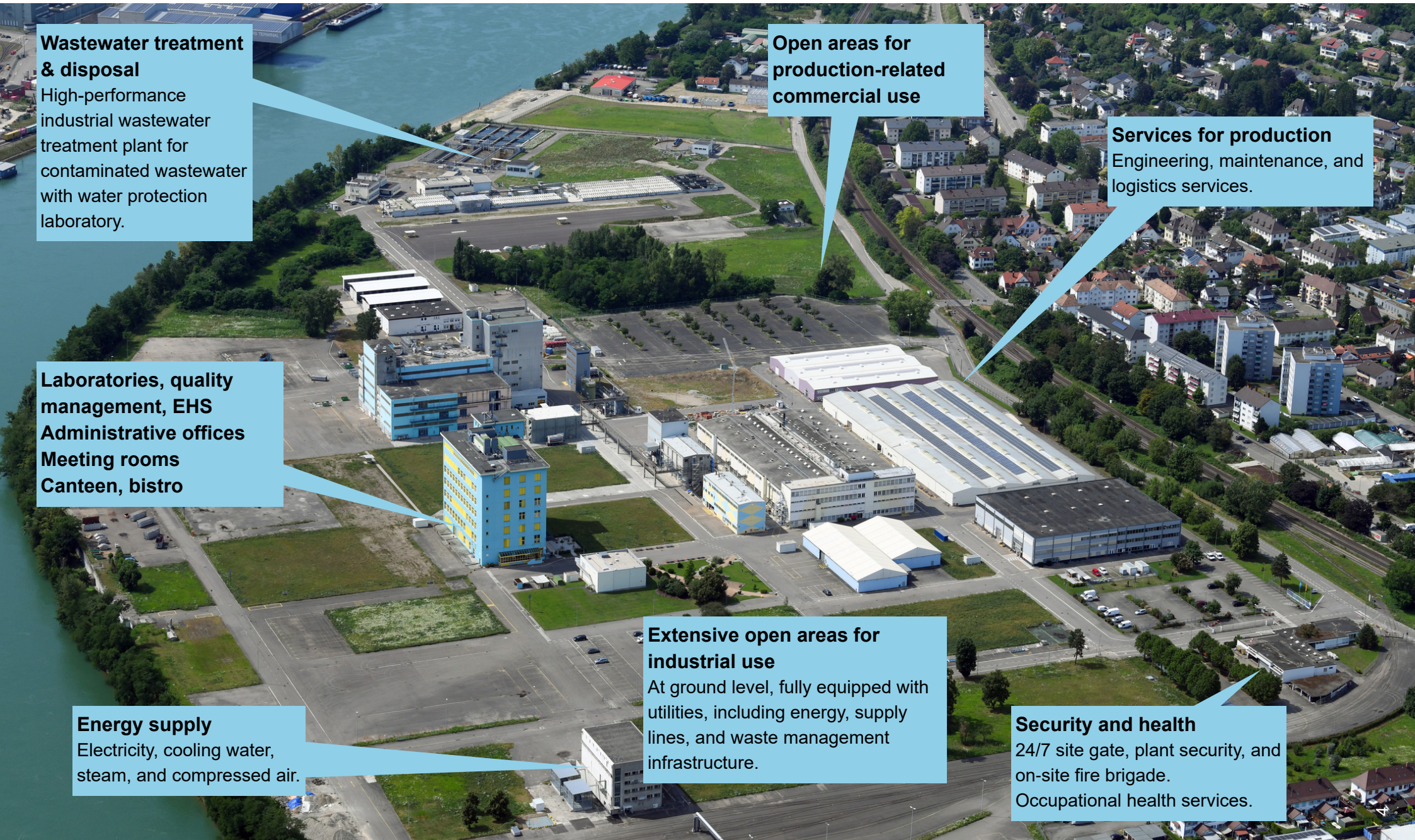

Get started quickly – open space for industry and commerce

BASF no longer utilizes all areas at its Grenzach site. As a result, around 57,000 square meters of flexible industrial space with wide-ranging usage options are now available for lease on the fenced site, which is secured by a gatehouse. The industrial spaces are at ground level and largely serviced via tunnels with utilities and other infrastructure services, allowing your company to simply build its assets and start running quickly. The north-western section of the industrial park, close to the wastewater treatment plant, also offers around 50,000 square meters of space for commercial enterprises.



GIE2: Limited industrial area 2, approx. 48,300 m²

Potential uses:

A wide range. For example, industrial plants that manufacture chemical or pharmaceutical products, in accordance with the requirements of the German Major Accidents Ordinance (Störfallverordnung).

Energy generation, raw material recovery, processing of a wide range of materials and surface treatment operations are also possible in this area.

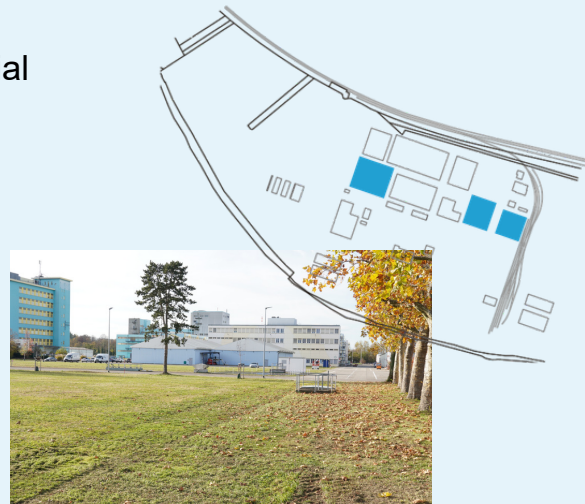
The large spaces and permitted building heights open up a wide variety of options.



GIE1: Limited industrial area 1, approx. 9,200 m²

Potential uses:

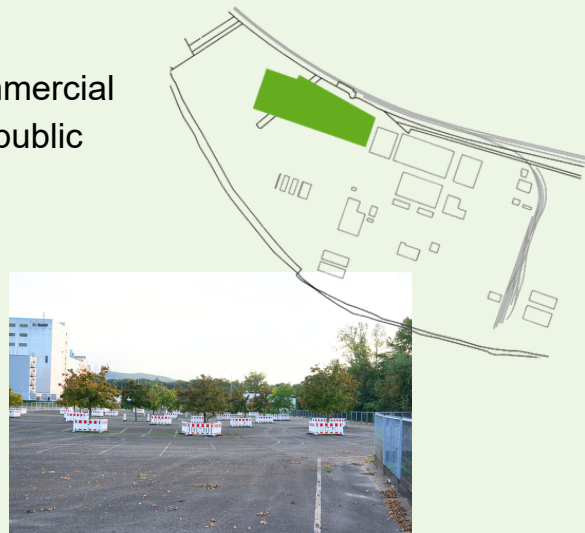
Quite a lot. This area is suitable for industrial plants that manufacture chemical or pharmaceutical products. We can also envision energy generation, raw material recovery, processing of a wide range of materials and surface treatment operations in this zone.



GEE: Limited commercial area, approx. 25,000 m²

Potential uses:

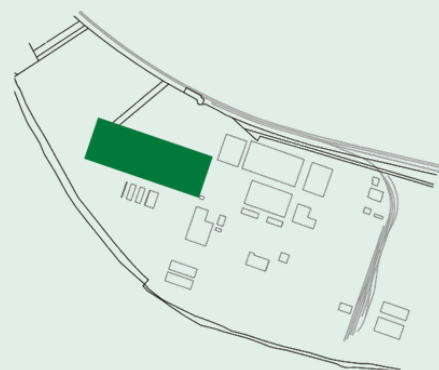
Numerous. This zone is well suited to commercial businesses with limited customer footfall, public enterprises or businesses, office and administrative buildings. With access from the B34 federal highway, this zone benefits from particularly convenient transport connections.



GE: Commercial area, approx. 25,000m²

Potential uses:

Extensive: Production-related commercial businesses, for example, can flourish here and build synergies with the industrial park. Public enterprises and businesses, office and administrative buildings with limited customer footfall are also feasible.



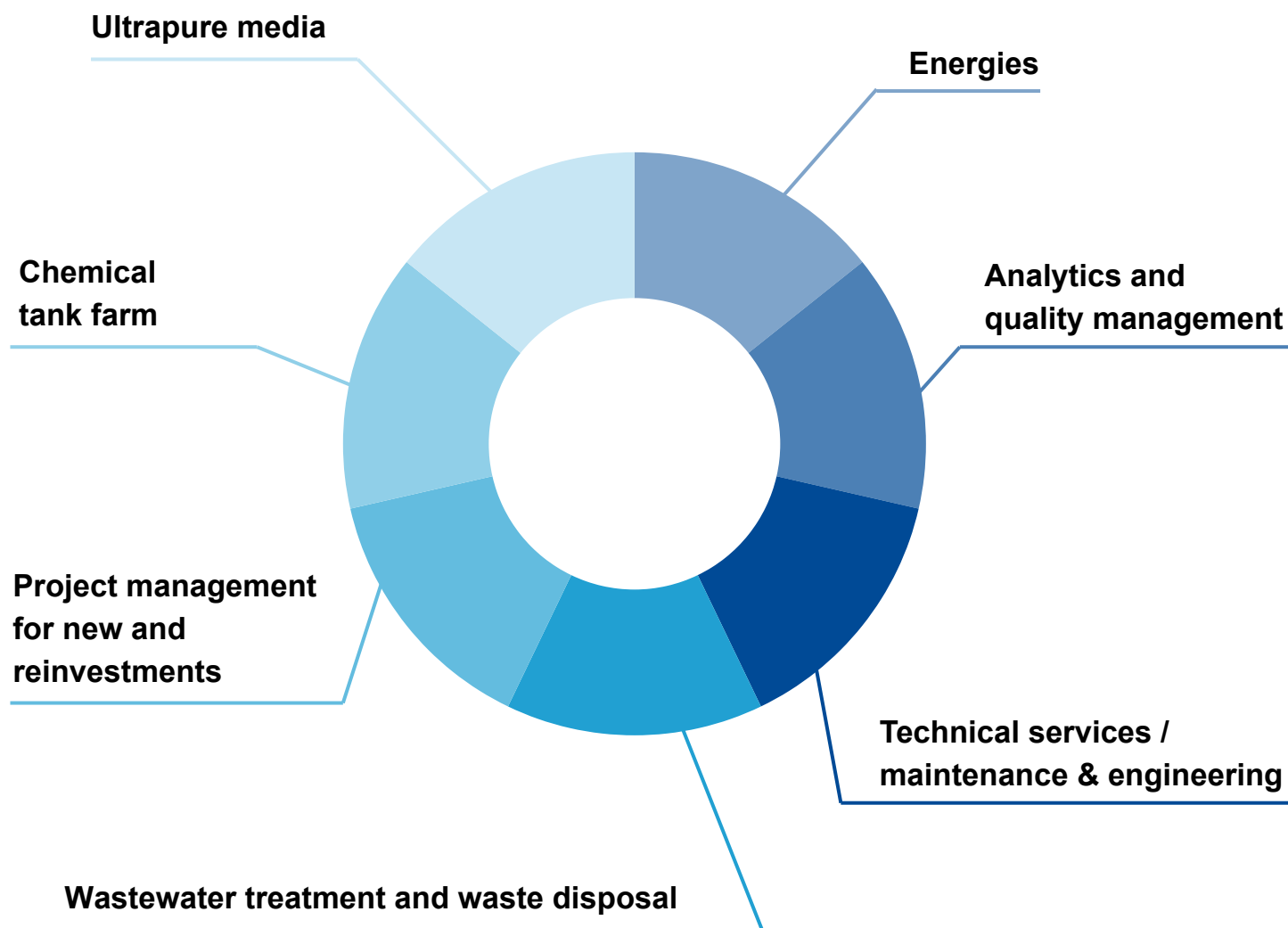

Wastewater treatment and waste disposal

The BASF Grenzach industrial park operates its own fully integrated wastewater treatment plant specializing in the purification and treatment of industrially polluted wastewater. It is also equipped with an emergency containment system. The municipal wastewater of the community of Grenzach-Wyhlen is treated on the site as well.

- Wastewater treatment plant with clarifiers, separators, thickening and removal of sewage sludge
- Environmental laboratory for wastewater analysis and environmental and industrial hygiene



Solid waste disposal

- Well-established disposal management for industrial and commercial waste.

Energy supply and equipment

Chemical and pharmaceutical production requires a variety of utilities and equipment, delivered reliably and without complications. The BASF Grenzach industrial park provides an integrated energy supply via supply tunnels along with equipment featuring consistently high availability and security of supply, so that you can focus on what you do best.

Electricity

- 20 kV / 6 kV connection
- Backup power supply

Compressed air

- Various supply grids available
- Pressure levels of 5.8–6.2 bar

Heating steam

- Steam pressure: 7 bar / 4.5 bar / 150–200 degrees Celsius

Nitrogen 8 bar / 99% purity

- On-site well system for water extraction
