Site Production

The Toronto site formulates and manufactures rigid and flexible polyurethane systems used in insulating and non-insulating applications. This includes BASF's WALLTITE® spray-applied polyurethane insulation/air barrier system. In addition to its production and lab facilities, the site is a major distribution centre for Master Builders Solutions and BASF Coatings divisions. The location is also used for technical training on the application of spray foam and automotive coatings.

Community Relations

BASF is active in the Toronto community, supporting science education, ecology, health and safety programs and other local community-based initiatives through monetary donations and employee volunteer efforts.
