The René Bohn House was inaugurated on February 12, 1960 after a 15-month construction period. It was initially used as accommodation for BASF volunteers.

For nearly 4 decades, it served as accommodation for works managers and technicians deepening their application options expertise at the BASF works premises. Since 1998, the house is also open for external guests as well as for business guests of BASF, and has developed into the leading business hotel in the metropolitan region Rhein-Neckar over the years.

In 2001, the building was completely renovated. Today, cubic forms and sophisticated light installations dominate the main entrance. The club area which was added in the year 2006 captivates with its retro designer look in soft sand and earth tones. The 2700 sq. ft. breakfast glass pavilion invites guests to start the day with a great meal. In addition, the 1600 sq. ft. large terrace lounge offers a pleasant atmosphere for business meetings or - at the end of an exciting day - for relaxation in the classy Asian flair environment.

The hotel has a total of 80 stylish and modern rooms as well as 11 serviced apartments. With a total capacity of 165 persons, the conference rooms Münster, Nanjing, Singapur and Tokyo ideally integrate into the overall concept of the business hotel.

About the name patron:

René Bohn was born on 7 March 1862 in Dornach and passed away on 6 March 1922. He studied chemistry at the technical university in Zurich, and graduated from there in 1883. In 1884, Bohn joined BASF. Within the scope of comprehensive examinations in the field of anthraquinones and its derivatives, he created that type of dye with INDANTHREN-Blue RS which due to its excellent and so far unparalleled properties became the starting point for a completely novel and great development. Characteristic for his working method and success was, that Bohn combined the knowledge of the practical application of dyes and the requirements of coloristics in a superior way with highly original, imaginative experimentation skills and a profound knowledge of the substances in his field of work. From 1906, René Bohn was a deputy member of the BASF executive board, and from 1919 a full member. From 1914 on, he carried the "Professor" title.
