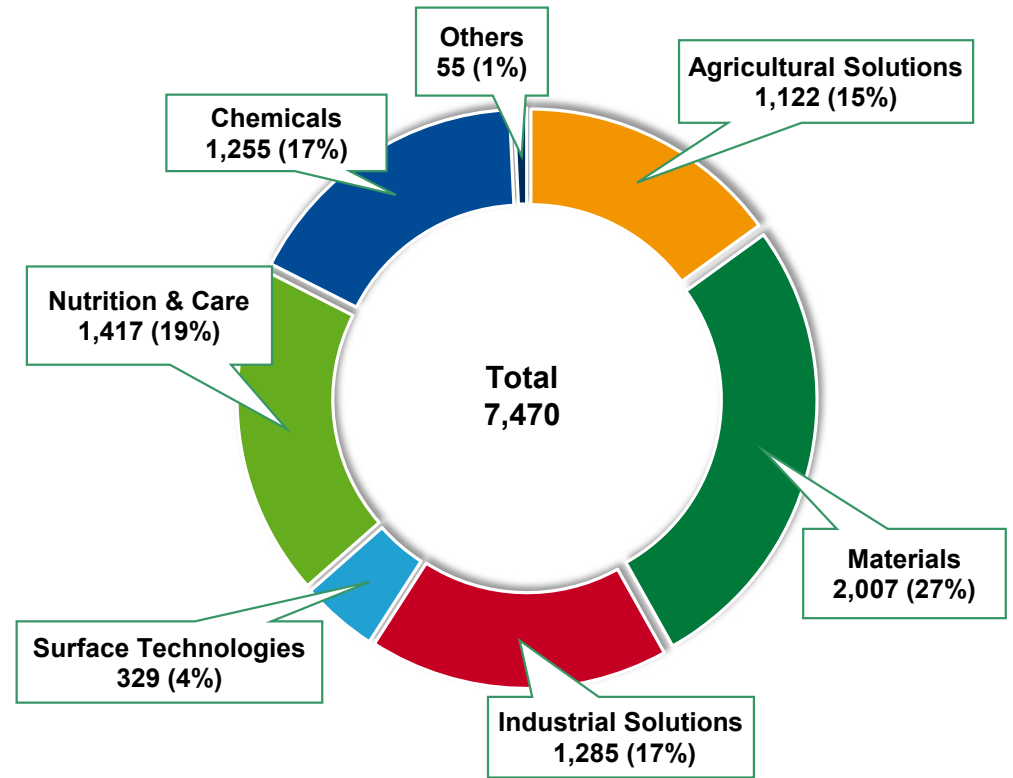

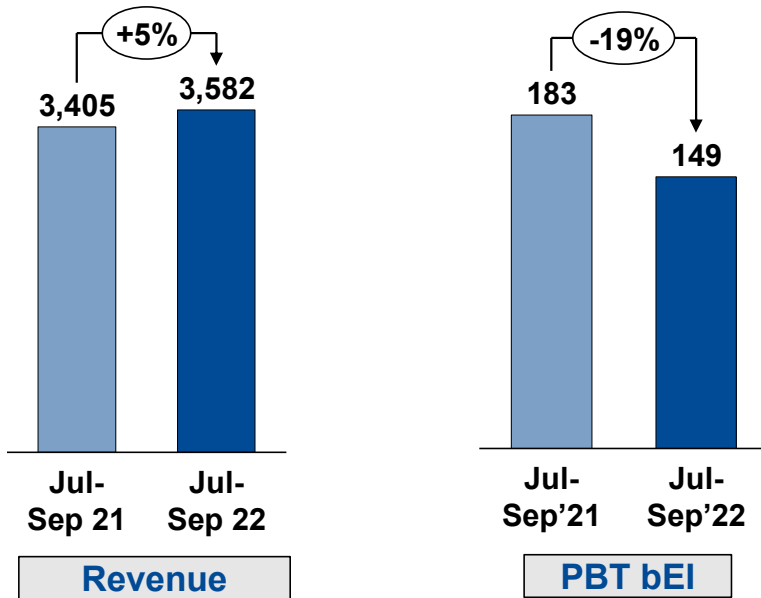

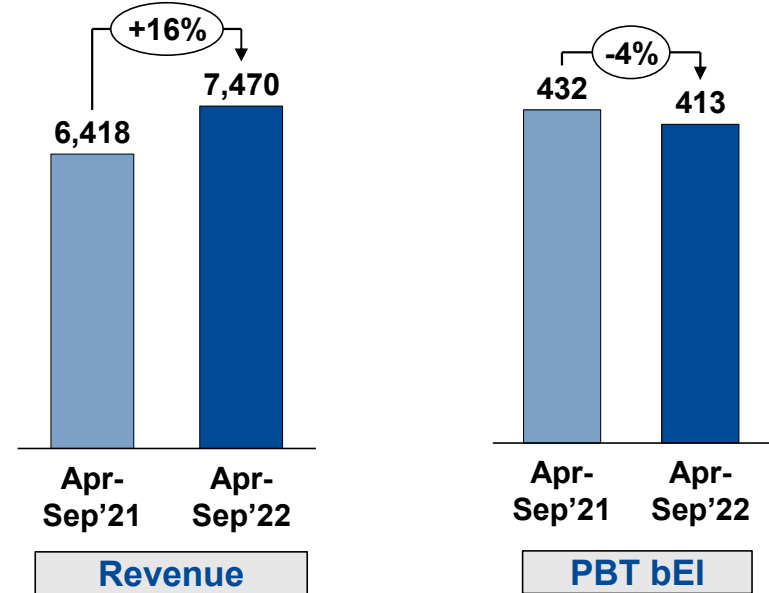

PBT bEI: Profit before tax before exceptional items

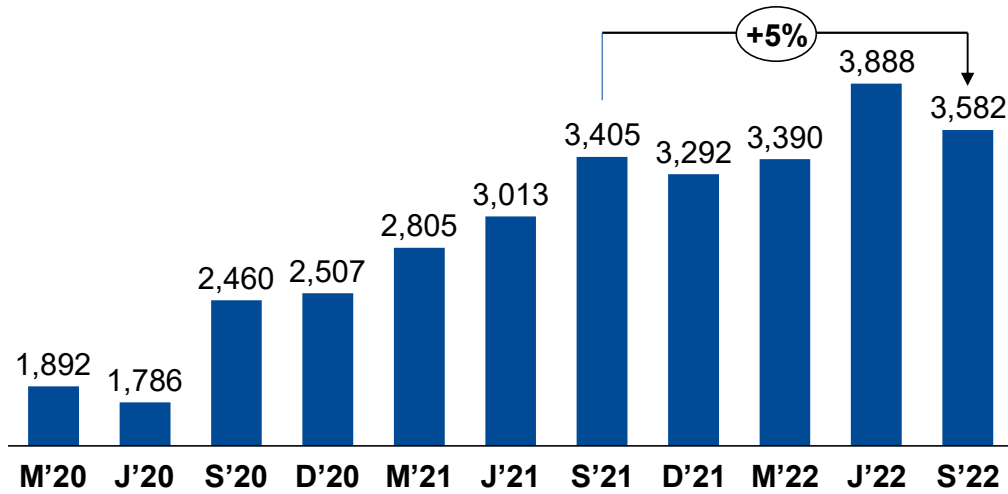

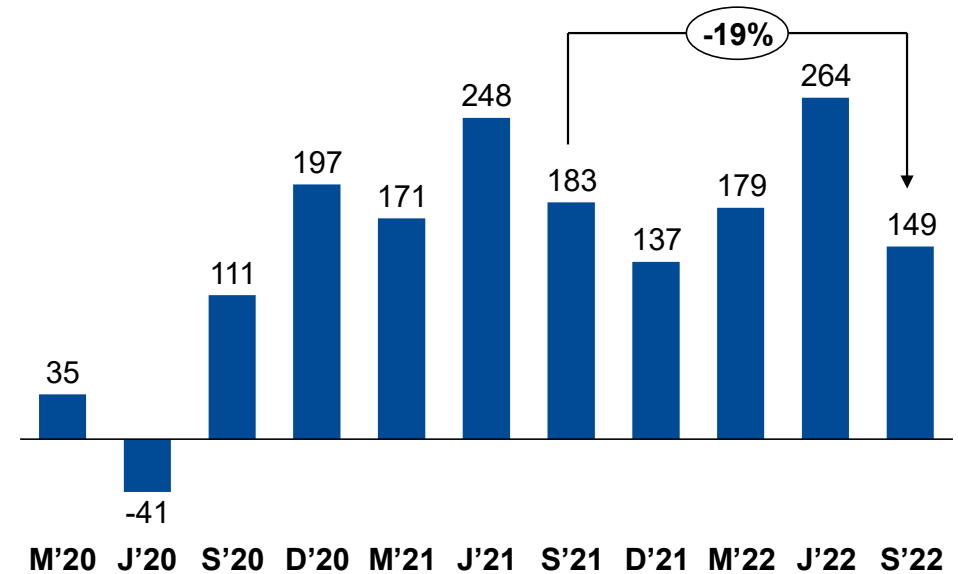
Quarter on Quarter Development

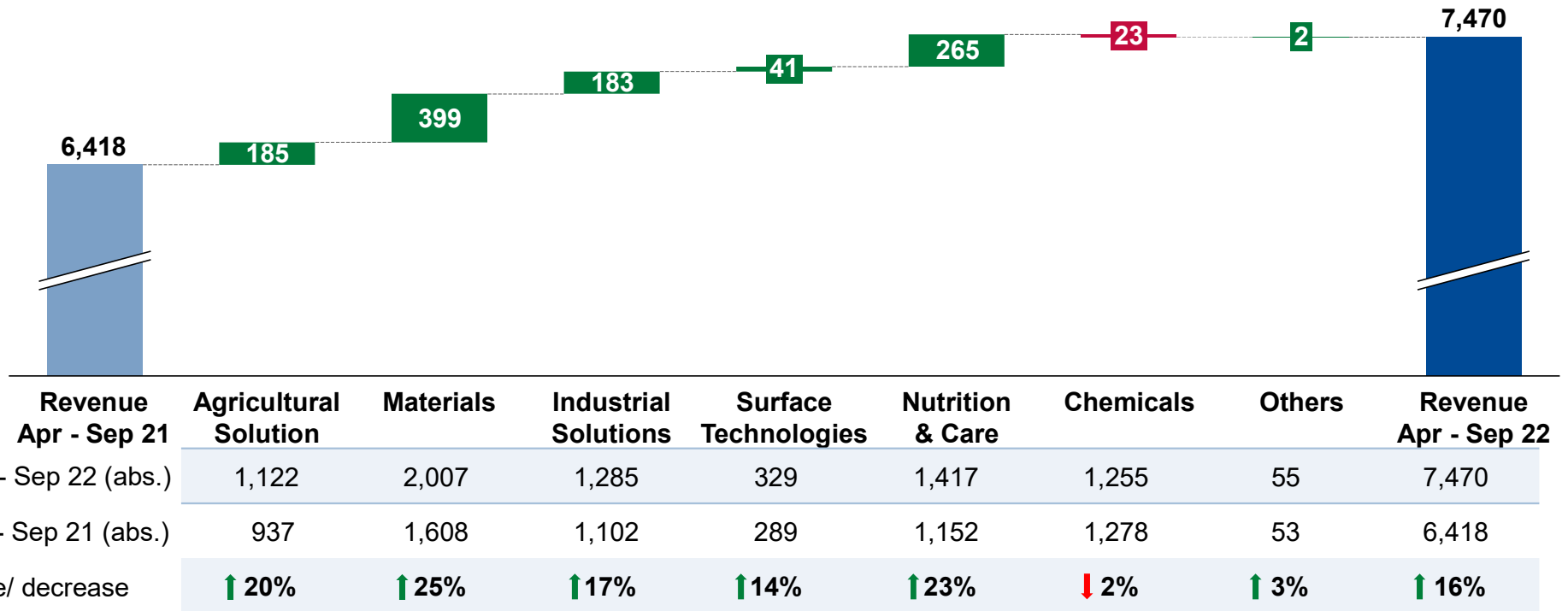

Apr to Sep 2022

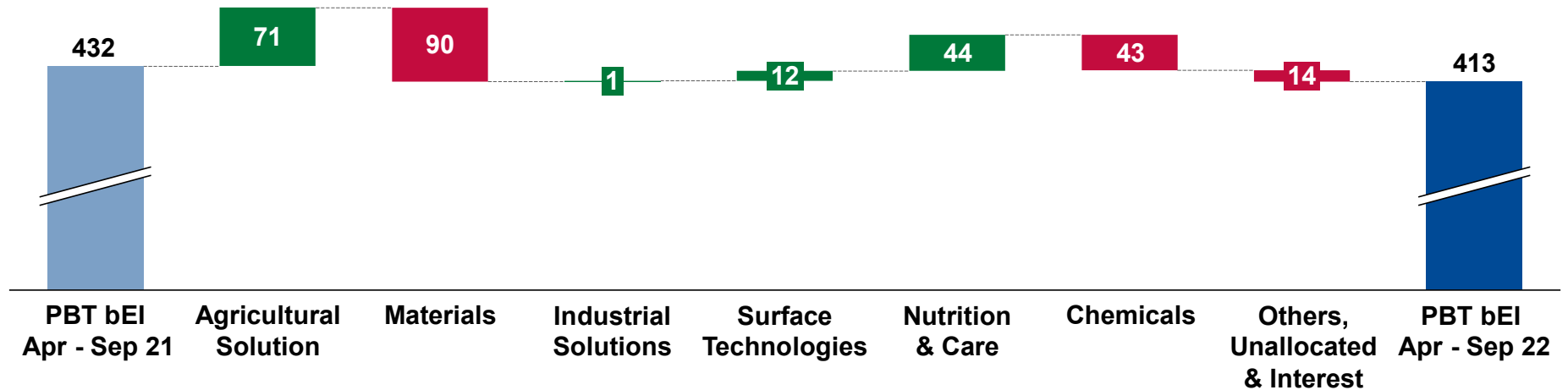
