The awards methodology included a detailed survey by the Directorate of Factories, Boilers, Industrial Safety & Health. An independent State level committee was set up by the Directorate to evaluate the performance of large, medium and small scale factories in the areas of Safety, Health, Welfare and Corporate Social Responsibility. Five companies were shortlisted in each category and a detailed site inspection / site audit was undertaken to choose the winners of the Safety awards.

The Mangalore site is BASF's largest manufacturing set up in India and in South Asia. It has been operational since 1996. It is engaged in the production of performance chemicals, dispersions and paper chemicals, automotive/coil coatings and construction chemicals. At the Mangalore site, BASF follows the highest standards of environment, health and safety (EHS) in line with BASF's global EHS standards.
