## Overview

At BASF, we create chemistry for a sustainable future. We combine economic success with environmental protection and social responsibility. Our portfolio is organized into six segments: Chemicals, Materials, Industrial Solutions, Surface Technologies, Nutrition & Care and Agricultural Solutions. BASF has been present in Singapore since 1978. BASF posted sales to customers in Singapore of about €241 million in 2018 and had 606 employees there as of the end of the year. BASF operates local production facilities and houses several regional business units in Singapore. Also based in Singapore are the BASF Learning Campus (Singapore), which offers leadership and business-related learning for BASF employees in Asia Pacific, and the Newtrition® Lab Asia Pacific, a technical application laboratory for its nutrition and health business.
