Petroleum cracking catalyst manufacturing facility

Products such as:

- Petroleum cracking catalysts used by petroleum refiners to transform crude oil into gasoline, jet fuel, diesel fuel, heating oil and fuel additives.
- Moving bed catalyst (MBC) used by petroleum refiners to “crack” large gas oil hydrocarbon molecules into lighter components, such as gasoline. BASF’s MBC operation in Attapulcus is one of the few remaining MBC manufacturing facilities in the world.
- Fertilizer co-product used by farmers.
