BASF Freeport manufactures products which can be found in more than a thousand different end-use products.

Products such as:

- Ammonium sulfate used in fertilizer
- Polyamide-6 used in fiber for carpeting and apparel, food packaging film to improve shelf life and light-weight parts for vehicles
- Acrylic monomers are used to produce paints, adhesives, caulks and sealants
- Super absorbent polymers which can be found in baby diapers
- Oxo Alcohol/Polyalcohol products are used to make wood finishes, PVC siding, oils, plastic coatings, and herbicides.
- The Dispersions plant produces architectural coatings, construction chemicals, and adhesives.

Community relations:

BASF along with local industry neighbors participate in a Community Advisory Panel (CAP) with more than 20 informed citizens representing environmental and community leaders from the Brazosport area.
